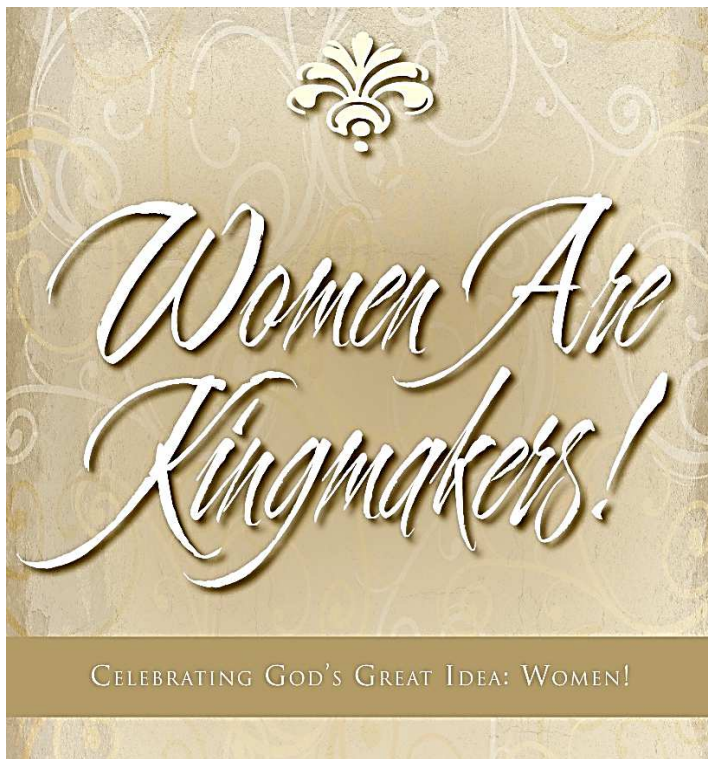

Through-the-Bible 12-Month Reading Plan

You can start reading on any day.

We follow a plan of reading four chapters daily from eight different sections of the Bible. If you maintain this schedule, you can read through the entire Bible in 12 months. Although this is a dated reading guide, not everyone will be able to start on January

1. Whenever you begin, simply find that date and start there. In that way, we will read the same chapters together on the same days of the year. At the end of the year, keep reading until you have completed the entire Bible and then begin again!

Women Are Kingmakers!

A Message from Bishop Wellington Boone

In every area of society, some women stand out from the crowd. I call them Kingmakers. They're the women that people remember. They're the women that people should listen to. They're the wives, mothers, teachers, and managers who helped others become what they are today. You don't see the mom behind a person who becomes great, but she's a Kingmaker, whether you see her or not. She's under acknowledged and underappreciated, but she's a Kingmaker just the same.

A Kingmaker is the wife that every man wants. She's the woman you want to manage your company. She's the team player who helps you to win. For a Kingmaker, no task is too difficult; no sacrifice too great. She's got an inner substance of life that makes a difference in the lives of others. She's a Kingmaker. A Kingmaker has the power of influence over another person's life and the ability from God to make that person great.

Are you a Kingmaker?

When you meet a Kingmaker, it doesn't take long to realize she's authentic. She's the real thing. You just love her integrity and her lack of manipulation. You see a woman without guile. A woman who doesn't try to build her self-esteem at your expense. She's already received her sense of value from Jesus. She's fulfilled. She knows God loves her, and that's where she gets her self-worth.

When people fail her and fall short in their relationships with her, she doesn't reject them. She draws on her inner strength to keep loving them, because she's grateful that God didn't reject her.

You can be that kind of woman

A KINGMAKER WORSHIPS GOD WITH PRAYER AND FASTING

One of the single women in the Bible who received special recognition was Anna, a prophet, an elderly widow who never left the temple. At the time that Mary and Joseph took the baby Jesus to present Him to God, she was in position to recognize who He was and praise God aloud for His future calling. She was sensitive to God's voice because her life was dedicated to "worshiping God with fasting and prayer."

"Anna, a prophet, was also there in the Temple. She was the daughter of Phanuel from the tribe of Asher, and she was very old. Her husband died when they had been married only seven years. Then she lived as a widow to the age of eighty-four. She never left the Temple but stayed there day and night, worshiping God with fasting and prayer. She came along just as Simeon was talking with Mary and Joseph, and she began praising God. She talked about the child to everyone who had been waiting expectantly for God to rescue Jerusalem" (Luke 2:36-38 NLT).

In the New Testament, fasting was part of the normal Christian life. It is a walk of humility that brings you closer to Christ-likeness. Your consecration is the kind of fast that God approves and honors with results (see Isaiah 58.). When you move beyond your dependence on food into a dependence on God, you come to see yourself, your family, your church, and nations of the world in the right perspective—God's perspective.

Jesus said, "And when you fast . . ." not "*If* you fast." You cannot walk in His power unless you walk in His fasting, humility, and suffering. Until you move past the domination of your flesh, you cannot walk fully in the Holy Spirit.

DANIEL FAST JANUARY 1-21 OR OTHER TIMES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR (21-Day Vegetable Fast)

Included

- Nuts. Vegetables (preferably fresh or frozen). Nuts and vegetables such as potatoes, beans, and soybeans will help provide substance.
- Pure fruit juices or fruit (no sweetened drinks or sweetened fruit): apple juice, orange juice, grapefruit juice, cranberry juice
- It is advisable to take vitamin, mineral, and possibly protein supplements.

Not Included

- Sugary foods, desserts, soft drinks, etc.
- Drinks including caffeine (coffee, tea, etc.)
- Bread
- Meats, fish, poultry, dairy products, eggs

Water

Drink 8 glasses of water daily throughout the fast. This is very important.

Personal sacrifice of marital intimacy

During the Daniel Fast, couples abstain from sexual intimacy as Paul noted in 1 Corinthians 7:5, "Do not deprive each other of sexual relations, unless you both agree to refrain from sexual intimacy for a limited time so you can give yourselves more completely to prayer. Afterward, you should come together again so that Satan won't be able to tempt you because of your lack of self-control."

Side effects to abstaining from certain food and drink

You may experience moderate to severe headaches for the first day or two as your body rids itself of caffeine, salt, sugar, and various impurities. You may need to take an analgesic like aspirin.

Important exceptions

Anyone with a medical condition related to eating or under the treatment of a physician must consult their doctor. Children, especially small children, will have special needs that must be considered. Under these conditions, find some sacrifice in the area of food that can be made without endangering health. Also, if you have

extreme difficulty with the fast, such as impairment of your ability to work at your job, you will have to make adjustments. This is not a failure of will but is wisdom. Seek the Lord and discuss it with other Christians.

*Jesus said, “**Then they shall fast**”*

Matthew 9:15 KJV

“And Jesus said unto them, Can the children of the bridechamber mourn, as long as the bridegroom is with them? but the days will come, when the bridegroom shall be taken from them, and then shall they fast.”

SELECTED SCRIPTURES ON FASTING

Jesus ate nothing (Luke 4:1-2). Jesus said, “*When you fast . . .*” Matthew 6:16-17. Jesus said, “*Then they shall fast*” (Matthew 9:15). Unbelief comes out through fasting (Matthew 17:19-21). Daniel would not defile himself (Daniel 1:8). Prayer and supplications, with fasting (Daniel 9:3). Daniel’s 21-day fast (Daniel 10). Fasting drives out unbelief (Matthew 17:14-21). Blessed to endure suffering (James 5:10-11). The fasting chapter—Isaiah 58. “In fastings often”—Paul (1 Corinthians 11:27). Covenant of sacrifice (Psalm 50:5). Prayed with fasting, commending them to the Lord (Acts 14:23). Consent to abstinence for a time of fasting (1 Corinthians 7:5).

The first corporate fast in the Bible is described in Leviticus 23, the Day of Atonement, which Jesus would have practiced and which the Jews still practice today as Yom Kippur. The continued observance of fasting on the Day of Atonement by the early Church is noted by its mention in Acts 27:9 as “the fast.” After Jesus was baptized by John, the Holy Spirit drove Him into the wilderness where He was tempted by the devil. The Bible says, “And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry” (see Matthew 4 and Luke 4). Then the tempter came to Him and said, “‘If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread.’ But He answered and said, ‘It is written, “Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.”’”

Jesus fasted and He expected Christians to fast. He said, “And *when you fast . . .*” (Matthew 6:16) not “*if you fast.*” You cannot walk in His power unless you walk in His fasting, humility, and suffering. Until you move past the domination of the flesh, you cannot fully walk in the Spirit. He also said to maintain a posture of humility, not pride. Keep your fast a secret between you and God. The goal is to draw near to God and build yourself up spiritually. “Moreover when ye fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces, that they may appear unto men to fast. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward. But thou, when thou fastest, anoint thine head, and wash thy face” (Matthew 6:16-17).

Some Who Fasted in the New Testament. Jesus; Anna, who saw the baby Jesus, John the Baptist; Paul, Barnabas, elders; fasting on the Day of Atonement

Some Who Fasted in the Old Testament. Ahab fasted for forgiveness; Daniel fasted while he confessed Israel’s sins; David fasted for his son, praying he would not die; he fasted for Saul and Jonathan; Day of Atonement ; Elijah—40-day fast; Esther asked Mordecai and others to fast before she went in to the king; Ezra read the law and the people repented; he led the people to fast before they returned from exile; Jehoshaphat fasted as his enemies advanced; Joel called for a solemn fast in a time of national distress; Moses fasted 40 days when he received a second copy of the Ten

Commandments; Nehemiah fasted over the condition of Jerusalem; Nineveh fasted after they heard the preaching of Jonah; Saul declared a fast for the soldiers but Jonathan unknowingly broke the fast; Zechariah rebuked the people for fasting the wrong way

Isaiah 58:6-11 NLT (excerpt)

*“No, this is the kind of fasting I want: Free those who are wrongly imprisoned; lighten the burden of those who work for you.
Let the oppressed go free, and remove the chains that bind people.
Share your food with the hungry, and give shelter to the homeless.
Give clothes to those who need them,
and do not hide from relatives who need your help.
“Then your salvation will come like the dawn,
and your wounds will quickly heal.
Your godliness will lead you forward,
and the glory of the Lord will protect you from behind.
Then when you call, the Lord will answer. ‘Yes, I am here,’ he will quickly reply.
“Remove the heavy yoke of oppression.
Stop pointing your finger and spreading vicious rumors!
Feed the hungry, and help those in trouble.
Then your light will shine out from the darkness,
and the darkness around you will be as bright as noon.
The Lord will guide you continually, giving you water when you are dry
and restoring your strength. You will be like a well-watered garden,
like an ever-flowing spring.”*

YOUR DAILY BIBLE-READING GUIDE

The Bible contains 1,189 chapters (Old Testament, 929 chapters; New Testament, 260 chapters). Reading four chapters per day, and repeating Proverbs and the End Times books of Daniel and Revelation, you can read every chapter in the entire Bible in 12 months.

Eight Divisions of the Bible Used in This Reading Guide

Pentateuch. Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy

History. Joshua, Judges, Ruth, 1 Samuel, 2 Samuel, 1 Kings, 2 Kings, 1 and 2 Chronicles, Ezra, Nehemiah, Esther, Acts (*1 and 2 Chronicles are read at the end of the Epistles. Acts is read after the Gospels.*)

Poetry. Job, Psalms, Song of Solomon, Ecclesiastes (*Ecclesiastes is read at the end of the Prophets.*)

Wisdom. Proverbs (*repeated during the year*)

Prophets. Isaiah, Jeremiah, Lamentations, Ezekiel, Daniel, Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, Malachi (*Isaiah is read after the Gospels and Acts, Daniel is read repeatedly during the year as an End Times book*)

Gospels. Matthew, Mark, Luke, John (*followed by Acts and Isaiah*)

Epistles. Romans, 1 Corinthians, 2 Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, 1 Thessalonians, 2 Thessalonians, 1 Timothy, 2 Timothy, Titus, Philemon, Hebrews, James, 1 Peter, 2 Peter, 1 John, 2 John, 3 John, Jude (*followed by 1 and 2 Chronicles*)

End Times. Daniel, Revelation (*repeated during the year*)

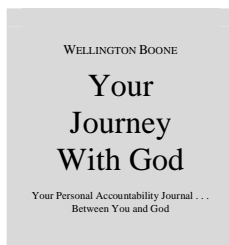

In January, you will read in Genesis Chapter 12 how much Abraham needed a Kingmaker for a wife. Behind the great man, Abraham, was a great woman, Sarah. Twice in the Bible we see that Abraham, fearing for his life, denied being married to Sarah and allowed a king to take her into his harem. Can you imagine what it took for her to submit to Abraham under those circumstances? Can you imagine the emotional challenges that she was facing? It's amazing to think about the kind of inner strength it must have taken for her to reverence him and call him "Lord." Abraham became the "father of faith," but Sarah was the woman of faith he needed. She was his Kingmaker.

With Jesus, we are heirs of all things!
